Call for Applications: ENGAGE.EU Data Management Days

New European and national regulations are pushing our universities to implement a data management policy that will change our research practices. In addition, researchers are increasingly required to develop a data management plan to respond to the European Commission calls for proposals. In this context, the European alliance ENGAGE.EU intends to promote the exchange of best practices and organise "Data Management Days" to foster collaboration in this area.

ENGAGE.EU is an alliance of leading European universities in business, economics, and social sciences, which aims to provide European citizens with the set of skills and competencies they need to face the challenges of the future.

This 3-day workshop will bring together one researcher and one support staff member from each university. It will take place from 6-8 March 2024 at Toulouse Capitole University and it will include several collaborative workshops and conferences. The aim of these workshops will be the facilitation of exchange, reflection and new initiatives in this field. We will also invite a panel of experts to provide you with new insights and expertise on general open science issues.

The University of Toulouse Capitole will cover the costs of accommodation, and both cultural and academic sessions. Transportation costs will be covered by the sending university. The event will start at noon on Wednesday the 6th and end at noon on the 8th.
